Many were the wonderful, caring Christians who created and sustained this church community that we now enjoy! It began with 85 households and help from Presbytery; Rio Rancho Presbyterian Church was built to serve members, friends and the community. We continue that work with about 200 members and are open to all! But our beloved church building is now over 35 years old! And our annual budget is an OPERATING budget, never intended to tackle major, nonroutine repairs.

But as any homeowner knows, those needs happen. We need major repairs to prepare the building for another 35 years. And delay only makes them more expensive.

We are the current occupants, and we have an obligation. The best guess-estimate was \$400,000 over 3 years, but it may be more now that we know the costs of the roof, HVAC and parking lot.

This will be a stretch for us, but faith brought us to this point in
